

ART CLAY SILVER - INFO



1
First you determine what the correct size of the ring should be. This can be done by using ring sizes.



2
Now that it is known what size the ring should be, this ring size is marked on a wooden tribulet with a pencil. Keep a shrinkage of 8 - 9% in mind.



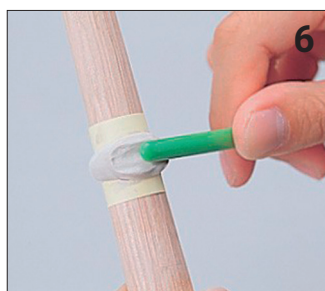

Use a Sticky note and stick it over the line on the wooden tribulet. The sheets are self-adhesive, but you can also attach them with adhesive tape.



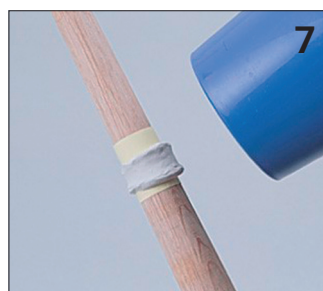

Make a roll from the ball of Art Clay Silver with your finger. If the clay is too dry, you can moisten it a little with water (don't make it too wet).



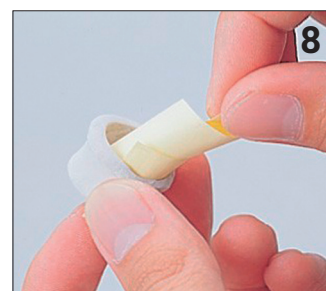

Once the intended shape has been obtained, the roll of silver clay is placed on the round wooden tribulet. This can then be further edited.

By using the back of a brush, the ring is modeled in its final shape. You can also use smooth spatulas.

You can now dry the model with a hairdryer. You can also use a heating plate or, if desired, let the model dry in the open air for 2 days.

When the model is dry, the ring is carefully removed from the tribulet and at that time the Sticky note can also be removed.

The model can be edited in a dry state with, for example, a file or sanding pads. Refilling or repairing the Art Clay is still possible.

Finish the inside of the ring with sandpaper. Be careful around the seam of the ring. If the ring isn't as you desired, repair it with paste and dry again.

The outside of the model is also not forgotten and fine sanding and/or polishing paper is also used here. This continues until the intended result is achieved.

The model is now ready to be heated. By heating, the binding agent will disappear from the Art Clay Silver and only 99.9% pure silver will remain.

For the best results, the ring is heated in an enamel oven. If you do not have this, a gas burner or the gas burner of a stove can also be used.

A metal hand brush can be used for the final finishing of the ring. But a browning steel and/or polishing paper can also be used.

The ring is ready!
